Junior Training Camps 2025



For boys in your outpost that are in <u>5th grade</u> and above, the Junior Training Academy is a great challenge in leadership, skills and spiritual growth. These camps provide a small group (patrol) environment to build teamwork and leadership.

Junior Training Camp (JTC) is the initial camp for basic skills and team building. It is the foundation for all other camps. Each camp has a strong spiritual emphasis and challenge. Cost is expected to be \$100 which includes all meals, camp shirt and ballcap. A young man that completes JTC, AJTC and 2 action camps can earn the Saber.

This year we will also offer <u>JMC</u> (Junior Missions Camp) where boys will build beds for 'Sleep in Heavenly Peace' for local needy families.

These camps will be conducted at <u>River of Life in Belleville</u> from <u>June 26th to June 28th</u>. Registration for these camps will be open in early May, posted on the *michrr.com* website and also emailed.


